At the present time we have 45 members, 28 are local and 17 are from a distance such as Texas, California, Arizona, and Florida. We exchange newsletters with 31 county genealogical societies in Iowa. These newsletters are displayed in a red notebook on the table in our Genealogy Room, and later filed in separate notebooks and placed on the shelf for future reference. Dues are still \$5.00 per year.

One copy is sent to Library of Congress at their request, nine are sent to surrounding State Genealogical Societies, and one copy goes to the Iowa Genealogical Society library, one to the State Historical Society and one to the State Archives, all in Des Moines, plus one copy goes to the Iowa State Historical Library in Iowa City. A considerable amount of genealogy records, know how and information is made available for our local genealogy society members through these.

Meetings for the next three months will still be on the third Thursday at 7:30 p.m. at the local library-(Enter through the side door)-(Don't forget to come!): June 19, July 17, August 21, 1986. Each meeting brings a special surprise, rejuvenates interest, and gives a desire to seek further information about onesroots.

Our PROJECTS are moving forward. Reading microfilm census and recording the information for future publishing are: 1856 census--Olen and Victor; 1860 census--Jerry & Sue, proof reading and typing; 1870 census--Mary Ellen; death, birth, marriage, reunions, etc. for 1986--Peggy; clipping newspapers, Helen Walker and Sue; microfilm ordering,--Verle, volunteers at library room during week--see Jerry Greene; plus more who are working on special things.

Don't forget that the Annual Meeting of Iowa Genealogical Society will be held in Ames this year, Friday, Oct. 31, Saturday, Nov. 1, 1986 at Scheman Auditorium. Mark the dates on your calendar.

A big thanks to Rowena Haselhoff for making an index to the Davis County Pictorial History, 1976, book. It was a tremendous job and a wonderful index to have. The index is located on our library shelves.

Ina Thompson has finished her ROSE family history for the present time. Anyone else finished theirs?

Olen McMains, our treasurer, is recovering from his operation. Don't take too long? A good treasurer is hard to find.

Ancestor Chart

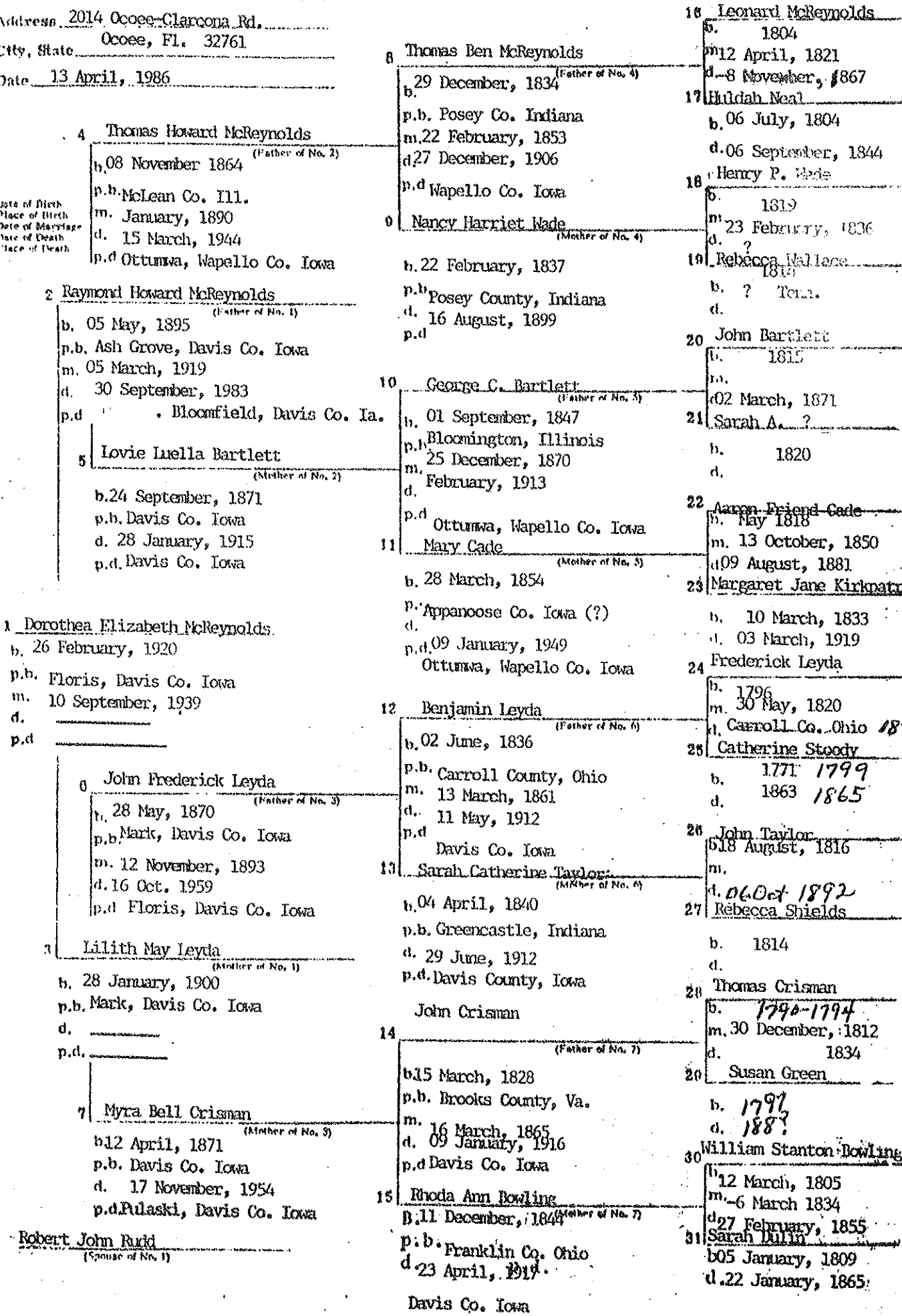

1925 IOWA CENSUS--The 1925 State Census of Iowa is a "gold mine" of information. It gives whether naturalized or not, years in the U.S., years in Iowa, name of father, his place of birth and age, name of mother, her place of birth and age, where parents were married, and if any military service. The census is available at Iowa Historical library in Des Moines. They also have the following cities indexed: Boone, Cedar Falls, Cedar Rapids, Centerville, Clinton, Council Bluffs, Davenport, Des Moines, Dubuque, Ottumwa, Sioux City, and Waterloo--
