Have you ever wondered about the color of an ancestor's eyes?

After hearing my father share his childhood memories of his grandfather's service in the Confederate Army, I decided to research his records. From these records, I was able to learn that he had enlisted in Jackson Co. Medora, Indiana, age 48 years, for a term of three years. He is listed on several Muster Rolls, then there is a certificate of disability for discharge. He is described as 5 feet 11 1/2 inches tall; complexion, dark; nativity, Wayne Co., Ky., occupation, farmer; eyes, hazel; age 49; discharged at Bowling Green, Ky. on Aug. 10, 1862. My father's father and three of his uncles served in the Civil War. One uncle was captured and died in prison.--Peggy Maxwell Arnold

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BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Taken from the Biographical Directory in the 1882 History of Davis County, Iowa, Fabius Township, p. 662.

JOHNSON, JEREMIAH (deceased), was born in Kentucky, in January 1836. When six years old, he came with his parents to this country. He was reared a farmer, and acquired his education in the schools of the early day. He engaged in farming until about 1877, when he went into the milling business. He passed away, to that bourne from whence no traveler returns, on the 22 day of August, 1881. SUSANNAH H., widow of the above named, was born in Harrison county, Ohio, and at the age of fifteen, came with her parents to this county, where she has since resided. She was married December 11, 1856, to Jeremiah Johnson, and they were blessed with eight children: George, James W., John H., U. Grant, Emma B., Sherman, Mary E. and Samuel. Mrs. Johnson is located on a good farm of 1,000 acres, mostly in cultivation, and the children all reside at home except the eldest. Mrs. J. is a worthy member of the Christian Church, and is surrounded with all the comforts of life.

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The ranch type house did away with the clutter in the attic and the basement -- now it's in the garage.

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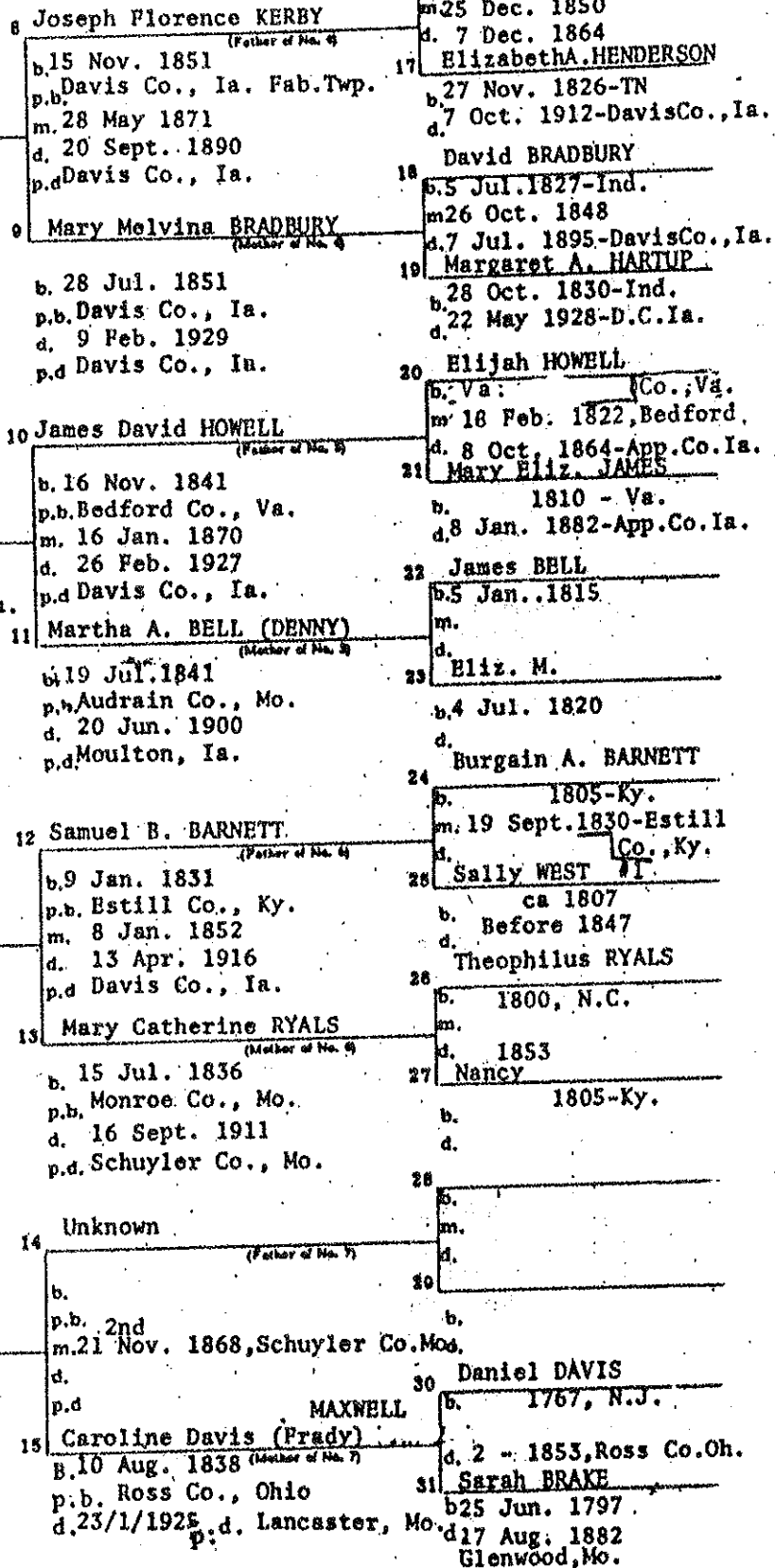
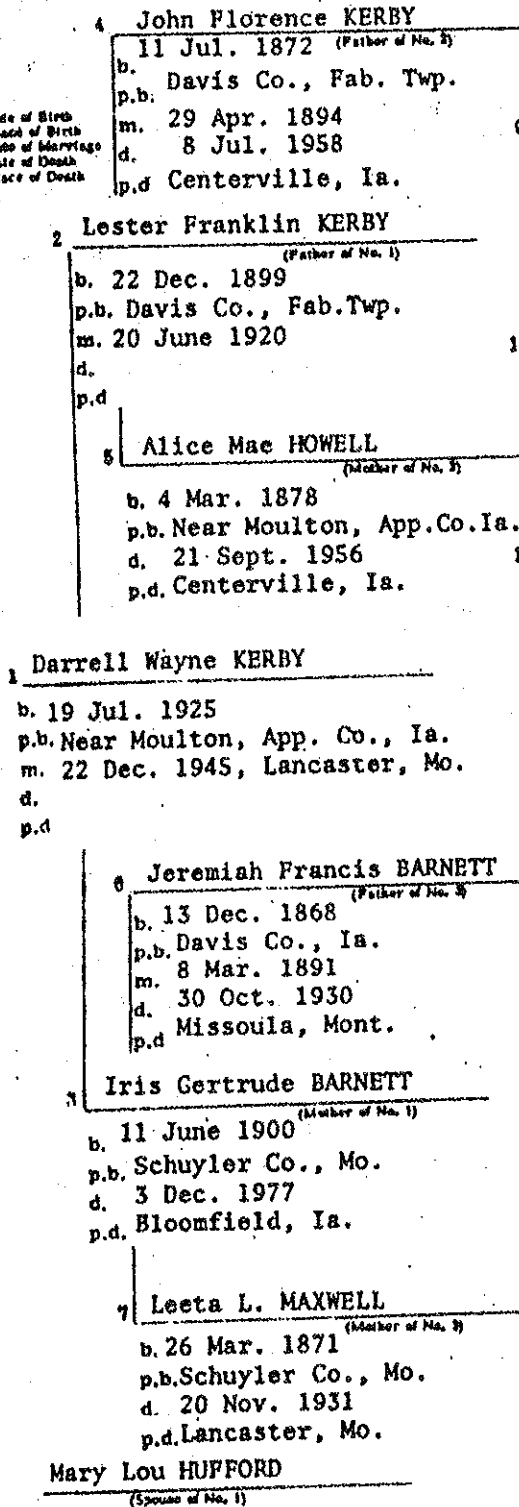
