DIED - SIDDALL -- In Vernon Springs township, Howard County, Iowa, on Monday, March 15th, 1875, James Siddall, aged 62 years.

Deacon James Siddall, after a brief illness of one week, died at his residence near Cresco, at 7 o'clock last Monday morning. He was a native of Canada, and emigrated with his family to the state of Illinois in 1839. In 1854 he came to this county and purchased as a claim the farm now owned by Mr. Lewis, two miles east of New Oregon. That place he sold after a few months and purchased the one where he has so long lived and where he died. He had been for many years a much-valued and beloved member and deacons of the Baptist church. The old settlers of this county, as well as many others who have more recently come to this regions, can bear testimony to Deacon Siddall's blameless life, to his integrity and up rightness in all his intercourse and dealings with his fellow men; a most kind and obliging neighbor. In his death his family has lost a kind, loving husband and father, the community a valuable citizen and the church one of its main pillars. The members of the Baptist church feel a sense of bereavement in the death of their beloved Deacon, second only to that of the family connections.

Deacon Siddall was buried on Tuesday; but in consequence of the severity of the storm the sermon and other religious services were postponed until Sabbath the 28th last at 11 a.m. at the Vernon Springs school house. As the deceased was one of the early settlers of this region, it is hoped a goodly number of that class will be present on that occasion.

The services will be conducted by Rev. C. E. Brown, of Lime Springs.

OBITUARY

Mary A Siddall was born in Southwold, Canada West, February 3, 1833, and died at Dell Rapids, S.D., Aug. 15, 1901, aged 68 years, 6 months and 12 days. She moved with her parents to Illinois in 1839 and then to Iowa in the summer of 1854, where she resided until a few years since when they removed to South Dakota. She was married Jan. 31, 1855 to Wm. Woodward, and to them seven children were born; three sons and four daughters, of whom five are still living; James, Henry A. and Elmer Woodward, Mrs. Lettie Buchanan and Miss Bertha, two daughters having died in childhood. In addition to these and the husband, an aged mother in Cresco, two brothers, James Siddall of this place and Daniel Siddall of Colorado, several grandchildren and other relatives are left to mourn her loss.

The remains were brought to Cresco for interment in the family lot at New Oregon Cemetery, the services being held at the Baptist church, of which denomination she was a faithful member, Rev. Silke officiating. The music consisted of the favorite hymns of the deceased and were sung by a choir selected by the relatives and consisting of Mesdames Geo. Miller and W.R. Owen and Messrs. Wm. J. Patterson and Dana Mead.

The funeral was largely attended by the friends and neighbors of the deceased as a last tribute to the esteem in which she was held by them. She was an affectionate wife, a kind mother and a good neighbor, and will be mourned by all who knew her. Accompanying the remains from Dakota were the husband, daughters, two sons, Elmer and James, with their wives, two granddaughters, Miss Irene Woodward and Miss Stella Buchanan, and Mr. Albert Holton.

OBITUARY

'William Woodward was born March 2, 1831, at Watertown, N.Y., and passed away Monday evening, Nov. 1, 1915, at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Geo. Buchanan, residing near Bonair, after having attained the age of 84 years and 7 months. At the age of nine years, Mr. Woodward moved with his parents to Toledo, Ohio, where he resided until 1854, when he came to Iowa, preempting in June of that year a farm located about a mile southeast of Cresco. In the same year he was united in marriage to Mary A. Siddall, one of the earliest if not the earliest marriages solemnized in the county. His wife preceded him in death on Aug. 15, 1901. To them were born seven children, three of whom are living and present at the funeral of their father; Mrs. Buchanan, of Bonair, and Mrs. Bertha Holton and Elmer, of Montana.

Mr. Woodward was identified with the earliest history of Howard county, having been elected its first recorder and treasurer at the first election held after its organization in June 1855. He held this office for two years, but was afterward at various times selected for responsible positions by his fellow citizens who knew him to be the soul of personal and business honor, serving at one time as one of the county board of supervisors and as assessor of the city of Cresco.

From the earliest days of the Baptist church in the county, he was actively identified with that denomination until his removal in 1889 to Dell Rapids, S.D., which was his home until his health failed about two years ago when he came to reside with his daughter, Mrs. Buchanan.

OBITUARY

Isaac B. Howland was born in the town of Meredith, Delaware county, N.Y., Dec. 26, 1827. United in marriage with Miss Nancy Siddall at Beloit, Wis., Aug. 19 1854. Moved to Iowa in the spring of 1863 and settled in Cresco. In December of the same year he enlisted in defense of the Union and the flag, leaving wife and two children deprived of his protection and care, a member of the 7th Regiment, Iowa Volunteer Infantry, company B. He fought in 13 engagements. Discharged July 1, 1865, he returned to his home after an absence of nearly two years. He settled on the home farm west of Lime Springs, and in 1893, moved to Lime Springs, where he has since resided.

He leaves two brothers, one sister, two sons and four daughters to mourn their loss. Died July 8, 1908, aged 80 years, 6 months and 12 days. He lives in the memories of his friends and loved ones.

W. E. Woodward, long-time resident of Cohagen, and former county commissioner of Garfield county, passed away at Dell Rapids, S.D. according to information received here this week. The end came Tuesday night, Dec. 22 following a long period of failing health.

Mr. Woodward sold his farm last fall and with Mrs. Woodward went to Dell Rapids to spend his declining years.

Mr. Woodward was elected county commissioner in the general election of 1930 and served for the six-year term. He was defeated for renomination in the 1936 primary election. He had been a resident of what is now Garfield county for 29 years.

OBITUARY - Richard Frost, retired rural mail carrier of Lime Springs, passed away at his home in Lime Springs last Wednesday evening, May 8, after an illness of pneumonia. He had celebrated his 90th birthday last November 19th.

Richard Frost was born in Tamerton Foliet, Devonshire, England, on November 19, 1866.

While an infant, he was baptized in the Evangelical Church of England, in which faith he remained during his life. When two years old, the family emigrated to the United States and after two years they settled in Howard County, which has been his home for 86 years.

He was the third child born to William Frost and Sara Vale, and the last to be born in England. Others were born here, the only survivor being his brother Fred of Charles City.

In 1892 he married Mary Howland of this locality. Five children were born to them, two dying in infancy. In 1943 he lost his youngest son William of Nashville, and in 1953 he lost his remaining son Vale of Miami Beach, who had given him much security in his declining years.

Mr. Frost worked in Lime Springs all his life.
