To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress approved September 28th, 1850. entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant No. 15987 for 80 acres, issued in favor of *Eber Stone Private Captain Bogarts Company New York Militia*

has been returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the Lots Numbered two and three of Section twenty two in Township ninety two North of Range twenty eight west, in the District of Lands Subject to Sale at Fort Des Moines Iowa containing eighty three Acres and forty hundredths of an Acre.

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL: which has been assigned to *Eber Stone*

Eber Stone Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said *Eber Stone*

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Eber Stone and to his*

heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof, I, *Franklin Pierce* PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
