**WHEREAS,** In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1855, entitled "An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, Warrant No. 1560 for 80 acres, in favor of Wilson Campbell bell, a private in Captain Sinks Company of Virginia Militia. War of 1812.

with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the South half of the North East quarter of Section twenty five, in Township ninety one North, of Range twenty seven west, in the district of lands subject to sale at Fort Dodge Iowa, containing eighty acres.

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** by the SURVEYOR GENERAL the said warrant having been assigned by the said Wilson Campbell to Sarah R. Harrington, in whose favor said tract has been located.

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Sarah R. Harrington, as assignee as aforesaid and to her heirs.

heirs and assigns forever.
