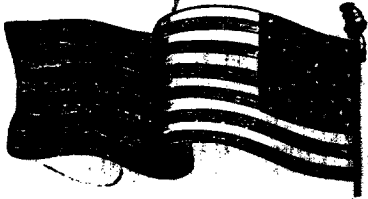

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1855, entitled "An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE,

Warrant No. *4433* for *120* acres, in favor of *William Green*

Private in Captain Burnell's Company, Maine Militia, North Eastern Frontier Disturbance,

with evidence that the same has been duly located upon ^{numbered} *Sots one, two, three and four* of Section Six, in Township *Ninety one North*, of Range *Twenty Eight*, West in the District of Lands Subject to Sale at *Fort De Moines Iowa*, containing *one hundred and twenty five acres and five hundredths of an acre.*

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL *the said warrant having been assigned by the said William Green to Dewitt C Roberts in whose favour said tracts have been located*

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said

Dewitt C Roberts as assignee as aforesaid, and to his heirs

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Dewitt C Roberts as assignee as aforesaid and to his*

heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, *James Buchanan* PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
