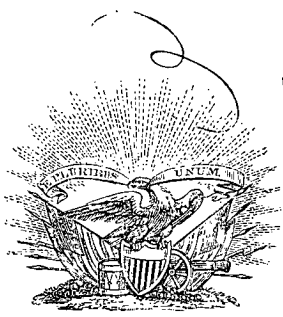


THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,



To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 28th, 1850, entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant No. 26,293 for 1600 acres, issued in favor of *Guinthane Mitchell* *Private* in *Captain Littlejohn's* *Company*, *United States Cavalry*, *War of 1812*

has been returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the North East *Quarter* of Section *Twenty-four*, Township *Ninety-one North*, of Range *Twenty-seven West* in the District of Lands Subject to Sale at Fort Dodge, *Nebraska* containing *one hundred and sixty acres*

Now know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said *Sarah Annor and Edward Annor*

the Tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Sarah Annor and Edward Annor and to their*

heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof, I, *James Buchanan* PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
