Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 28th, 1850, entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant No. *20.622* for *160* acres, issued in favor of *Christopher S. Lovell a Captain, Second Regiment of United States Infantry - Mexican Infantry*

has been returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the *South East quarter of Section Two, in Township Ninety-two North, of Range Twenty-eight West, in the District of Lands Subject to Sale at Fort Dodge, Iowa, containing one hundred and sixty acres*

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL: *which has been assigned to Daniel McCauley*

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said *Daniel McCauley*

the Tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Daniel McCauley*

heirs and assigns forever.
