THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greetings:

KNOW YE, That, in pursuance of the Acts of Congress, appropriating and granting LAND to the late ARMY OF THE UNITED STATES, passed on and since the Sixth day of May, 1812, Warrant No. *27963* for *160* acres, issued in favor of *Robert Barr who was a Private in the Company commanded by Captain Post, of the Twelfth Regiment, U. States Infantry.*

has been returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the *South West quarter of Section Twenty-four in Township Ninety-one North of Range Twenty-seven West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Fort Dodge, Iowa, containing One hundred and sixty acres*

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been located in satisfaction of the above mentioned Warrant, in pursuance of the act of Congress, approved 27th July, 1842, and under the provisions of the Act of Congress approved "March 22d, 1852," said *Warrant* has been assigned by the said *Robert Barr unto Joseph Caldwell*

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said *Joseph Caldwell*

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Joseph Caldwell*

and to his heirs and assigns forever.
