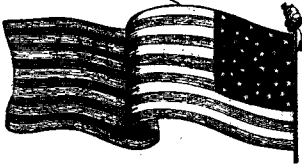

THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1855, entitled an "An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, Warrant No. 17797. for 80. acres, in favor of Luke Robinson, Private, Captain Weston's Company, Georgia Militia, Nov 1862

with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the East half of the South West quarter of Section twelve, in Township Ninety two, North, of Range twenty Eight, West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Fort Dodge, Iowa, containing Eighty acres.

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL the said premises having been assigned by the said Luke Robinson to Eliza C. Safford, in whose favor said tract has been located,

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Eliza C. Safford, as assignee as aforesaid and her heirs

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Eliza C. Safford, as assignee as aforesaid and her

heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, James Buchanan PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
