To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1855, entitled "An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," there has been deposited in the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE**, Warrant No. *14645* for *160* acres, in favor of *Jacob Briminstool Musician Captain Bancroft's company New York Militia War 1812*

with evidence that the same has been duly located upon *the North West quarter of section Twelve in Township Ninety two North of Range Seventy seven West, in the District of Kansas subject to sale at Fort Dodge Iowa, containing one hundred and sixty acres.*

according to the **Official Plat** of the Survey of said Lands returned to the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL**, *the said Warrant having been assigned by the said Jacob Briminstool to Henry G. Hartman, in whose favor the said Tract has been located.*

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said *Henry G. Hartman, as assignee as aforesaid and to his heirs*

the tract of Land above described **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Henry G. Hartman, as assignee as aforesaid and to his*

heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, *James Buchanan* **PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the **SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE** to be hereunto affixed.
