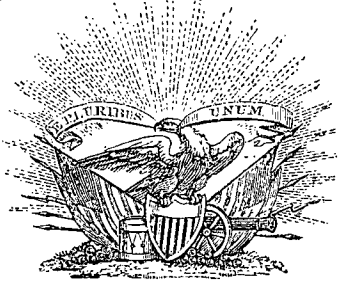

THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,

To all to Whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 28th, 1850, entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant No. 28143 for 40 acres, issued in favor of Joseph Robinson, Major of the Twentyseventh Regiment Marylands Militia, War of 1812, Battle of North Point,

has been returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the North West quarter of the North East quarter of Section Fourteen in Township Ninetytwo North, of Range Seventy seven West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Fort Dodge, Iowa, Containing Forty Acres,

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL: which has been assigned to R.C. Maples and R.M. Wabmsley,

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said R.C. Maples and R.M. Wabmsley,

the Tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said R.C. Maples and R.M. Wabmsley and to their

heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof, I, James Buchanan PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
