To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas James C. Cusey of Humboldt County Iowa

has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States, a Certificate of THE REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE of Fort Dodge whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said

James C. Cusey according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 21st of April, 1880, entitled "an act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the North West quarter of the North East quarter of Section eight in Township ninety two North of Range twenty eight West in the District of Lands subject to sale at Fort Dodge Iowa containing forty acres

according to the official plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said James C. Cusey

NOW KNOW YE, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said James C. Cusey

and to his heirs, the said tract above described, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said James C. Cusey and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof I, James Buchanan, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made PATENT, and the SEAL of the GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
