

JUSTICE ARRESTED ON CHECK CHARGE; SON ALSO IS HELD

George Regenberg Is Re- leased on Bonds of \$1,000

Justice of the Peace **George Regenberg**, 811 Fifteenth street, Moline, is under arrest on a charge of operating a confidence game. He was arrested yesterday at his home on a state warrant sworn to by Rose Sedler.

It is claimed that he went to visit with the Sedlers and gave them a check to purchase meat for dinner. He remained for dinner and later the check came back marked "no funds." Other checks are said to be out.

The justice was released under \$1,000 bonds to appear in police court on May 21 before Magistrate Frank Gustafson.

Son Is Arrested

When the police went to the **Regenberg** home to arrest the justice they noticed a radio set that answered the description of one stolen from the home of W. G. Winder, Tenth avenue and Forty-sixth street, Moline, earlier this week. They questioned the son of the justice and claim that he confessed that he stole the set and the \$8 from the home.

Joe Regenberg is 16 years old and has been apprehended by the police on other occasions for running away from home. The youth had cut the radio and one stage of amplification from the set in an effort to disguise its police claim. The youth's hearing will be held Thursday.
