

Fritz made his living as a farmer, and he and his family made their home in Dale Township, Lyon County, State of Iowa and resided there for the next 27 years.

The 1885 census for Lyon County, Dale Township, State of Iowa, listed the following residents in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 32, Township 98, Range 43:

FRITZ – Married - age 62, male, farmer, born Germany, father & mother born in foreign country, entitled to vote

ERNESTINE (EURSTINE) – Married – age 37, female, keeping, born Germany, mother and father foreign born

GEORGE – age 11, male, born Pennsylvania, parents born foreign country

EMMA – age 9, female, born Wisconsin, parents born foreign country

ANA – age 8, female, born Wisconsin, parents born foreign country

MATTIE – age 6, female, born Iowa, parents foreign born

EDA – age 2, female, born Iowa, parents foreign born

FRANK – age 0, male, born Iowa, parents foreign born

(Otto was residing in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 18, Township 97, Range 43, Grant Township, working as a farm laborer on the Peter & Mary Egan farm in Sioux County, Iowa, as appears in the 1885 Census for Iowa)
