Otto Regenberg Buried Monday

Had Been a Resident of This Community For Many Years

Funeral services for Otto Regenberg were held at the Methodist church yesterday. Mr. Regenberg died here Thursday morning, after a long illness. Immediate cause of death was heart disease.

Born in Germany

Mr. Regenberg was born in Germany September 14, 1865. He was the son of Fritz and Ernestine Regenberg. When he was six years of age he came to Pennsylvania where the family lived for a time. Later he moved to Wisconsin and finally came to Iowa, where he located near Matlock.

The deceased farmed near Matlock until 1908, when he came to Rock Rapids. For a long time he worked at the mason's trade, being on John Olson's crew for many years. Eleven years ago he was taken seriously ill and since then has been in a feeble condition.
