five years, next preceding his admission, without being at any time during the said five years out
of the territory of the United States, and within this State one year at least; and it further
appearing to the satisfaction of this Court; that during that time he has behaved as a man of good
moral character, altached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States, and well disposed
to the good order and happiness of the same; thereupon the Court admitted the said applicant to
become a citizen of the United States, and ordered all proceedings oforesaid to be entered of record.
