MATTIE REGENBERG UDEN

1878 — 1963

Mattie Regenberg Uden, daughter of Frederick and Ernstine Blivert Regenberg, was born November 1, 1878 in Dale Township, near George, Iowa. She went with her Lord September 9, 1963 at the age of 84 years, 10 months, and 8 days.

She was a lifetime resident of the George area and was united in marriage to U. A. Uden on May 7, 1902, moving into the city in 1908. There were no children. Mrs. Uden entered into the fellowship and work of the Evangelical Church in 1900, just ten years after the beginning of the local church. She was a member of the Ladies Aid when the work was carried on in the German language, and a charter member of the Women's Missionary Society

when it was organized in 1915.

Those preceding her in death are her husband, U. A. Uden March 7, 1940, a sister, Edith Regenberg of Rock Rapids August 21, 1963, two other sisters and three brothers. Left to miss her are a brother, Frank Regenberg of Rock Rapids, two nephews and one niece. And with these relatives a great many friends and acquaintances to whom her life was a powerful witness in enduring patience and faith. The last three years and a half were spent as a patient in the MPC Hospital, Rock Rapids.
