On May 7, 1902, he was united in marriage with Miss Mattie Regenberg, with whom he shared the joys and sorrows of life. Mr. Uden followed the line of operating a threshing outfit, at which he was very successful. In 1908 he sold his machine and moved into George, where he operated a machine shop until his health forced him to retire. He enjoyed fair health until about two years ago, when he began to fail, and since then suffered a steady decline. Friday morning, March 1, he was taken ill and continued to grow worse.

Surviving are the widow, one sister, Mrs Ella Uden, and a host of other relatives and friends.
