*the East half of the North West Quarter and the North West Quarter of the North West Quarter of Section ten in Township Ninety two North of Range thirty one West in the District of Lands subject to Sale at Fort Dodge Iowa containing One hundred and twenty acres*

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** by the SURVEYOR GENERAL

*the said land having been assigned by the said Hotulka Sipico to B W Taylor and by him to Henry Ainsworth in whose favor said land has been located* NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said *Henry Ainsworth as assignee as aforesaid and to his heirs*

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Henry Ainsworth as assignee as aforesaid and to his*

heirs and assigns forever.
