

MRS. VERNIS ALDAG

Marlene Gloria Aldag was born on Nov. 3, 1932 at Alhambra, Calif., the daughter of Dr. Frank Mussler and Zella Guynn Mussler. She died July 15, 1986 at the Crawford County Memorial Hospital at the age of 53.

Marlene spent her early years in Alhambra, Ca., and in her first years of school, she attended St. Mary's, and later, Eglerock High School in Eglerock, Ca.
