MRS VAN O. ANTHONY, 78

IRWIN — Emma Anthony, daughter of Hans and Margaret Petersen Hansen, was born on a farm in Crawford county, Ia., on June 2, 1895. She died at her home in Irwin, on Febr. 23, 1974 at age 78 years, 8 months and 21 days. On Feb. 10, 1926 she married Van O. Anthony in Atlantic, and one daughter was born to this union. After their marriage, Mr and Mrs Anthony farmed east of Irwin for six years before moving into their home in Irwin in 1932. This has been her home since that time. Mrs Anthony was a member of the Church of Christ in Irwin.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Van, on July 14, 1971; by her parents; and three brothers - Peter and William Hansen and an infant. Mrs Anthony is survived by her daughter, Inez L. (Mrs John T. Faulkner) of Lakewood, Colo.; by two brothers - Claus Hansen of Aspinwall, Ia. and Art Hansen of Sacramento, Calif.; and by one sister - Margaret (Mrs Leslie Van Osdol) of Manilla, by her nieces and nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Wednesday, Feb. 27, 1974 at the Pauley Home for Funerals in Harlan with Pastor S. L. Schuler, of the Church of Christ, officiating. Burial was in the Oak Hill cemetery in Irwin with Lorren Clark, John Paulsen, Richard Larson, Normal Richards, Kenneth Thompson and Louis Jensen, Jr. serving as pallbearers.
