Henry Axland, son of Marcus and Rachel Hanson Axland was born Aug. 20, 1914 in Polk twp., Shelby co. He attended the rural schools through the eighth grade. He had been a farm laborer for most of his life and also worked for the Milwaukee Railroad for a short time. For over 35 years he made his home with his good friend Albert Guth. He and Albert lived near Manning and later in Audubon.

After Albert's death in Dec., 1982, he lived with and was cared for by members of his family. He lived in a senior citizen apartment in Irwin for several months and was a resident of the Manilla Manor Nursing Home for one month. He died at the Manilla Manor on Friday, Sept. 2, 1983 at the age of 69 years and 12 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents; by four sisters, Emelia Nelson, Elva Guth, Gladys Rogers and one sister, in infancy and by his friend, Albert Guth, also other relatives. He is survived by one brother and three sisters, Elmer Axland of Irwin, Mrs Mae Campbell and Mrs Nellie Ickes. He was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith at St. Paul's Lutheran church in Irwin.

Funeral services were held Monday, Sept. 5 at St. Paul's Lutheran church in Irwin. Burial was in Danway cemetery near Irwin.
