

# Ruby Barratt, 60

Irwin — Ruby Barratt, daughter of Edward and Marie Wenzel Hamann, was born July 8, 1918, near Manilla. The family moved to a farm southeast of Manilla, where Ruby lived until she married. She was baptized and confirmed in Trinity Lutheran church in Manilla. On Feb. 12, 1939, she married Raynard Hanson. Four children were born to this union. They farmed near Manilla and Irwin. Raynard died in Sept. of 1972.

Ruby married Marvin Barratt on Aug. 30, 1975. They have made their home in Irwin, and was an active member until her death on Friday, June 8, 1979, at age of 60 years, and 11 months.
