

Anna M. Behrendt, 97

Portsmouth — Anna Maria Behrendt, daughter of William and Rosella Behrendt was born June 26, 1883 in Westphalia and was baptized at St. Boniface Catholic church in Westphalia. As a child, she moved with her family to Portsmouth where she grew to adulthood and then lived with her brother in Portsmouth, keeping house for him for the next 50 years. In 1971, Anna moved into the retirement home in Logan for two years and for the last eight years, she has been a resident of Little Flower Haven Nursing Home in Earling. Miss Behrendt was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church in Portsmouth. She died at the Little Flower Home on May 2, 1981 at age 97 years, 10 months and 6 days.

In addition to her parents, Anna was preceded in death by two brothers, Martin and John and one sister, Wilhelmina Schleimer.
