Raymond C. Berndt, 72

Raymond, son of Henry and Caroline Thomsen Berndt was born Feb. 17, 1910 at Irwin. He graduated from Irwin high school in 1928.

He married Alice Jae Johnson on Sept. 27, 1933 at Shenandoah. He worked for the Kimballton Creamery for 13 years. Then he operated the Skelly Service Station in Manilla for eight years. He worked for Rasmussen Lumber Co. for 12 years and for the Manning Ready Mix for 8 years. He retired in 1972.
