

## Geraldine F. Biederman, 50

Nebr. — Geraldine Faye Biederman, daughter of Emma Jensen and Victor Olsen, was born in Hamlin, on April 5, 1929. She died Thursday, Feb. 7, 1980 at Nashville, Neb., at age 50 years, ten months and two days as a result of an automobile accident.
