

Dr. Carl V. Bisgard, 76

Harlan — Dr. Carl Valdemar Bisgard, son of Mary Mortensen and Dr. James Bisgard was born Feb. 28, 1904, in Harlan. He died at his home in Harlan, Sunday, Jan. 18, 1981, at age 76 years, 10 months and 20 days. He was raised in Harlan, he attended the Univ. of Iowa and graduated from Harvard Medical School in 1928. He did his post graduate work in New York State. In 1934, he started his medical practice in Harlan.

On Jan. 25, 1936, he married Constance Lamar in Sioux City. This union was blessed with three children. During WW II, he served as a physician for four years in the Navy. He retired from his practice in 1974. Dr. Bisgard was a member of the Congregational Christian United Church of Christ of Harlan and a member of the Harlan Golf and Country Club.

He was preceded in death by his parents, one brother, Dr. J. Dewey Bisgard and one sister, Mrs Vernie M. White. Survivors include his wife, Constance of Harlan, two sons, Dr. Carl Bisgard of Walla Walla, Wash., and Bill Bisgard of Maui, Hawaii, and one daughter, Mrs Ellen Barrett of Reading, PA., by eight grandchildren, nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Wednesday, Jan. 21, 1981 at the Congregational Christian church in Harlan with Rev. David E. Cave, officiating. Burial was in the Harlan cemetery with Steve Mores, Orlin Pauley, Clifford Hanson, Curran S. Swift, Cletus H. Schmitz and Bennett Cullison, Jr., serving as casketbearers.
