

THE LIFE STORY OF —

1984 A.R. "Jack" Boeck, 77

Jack, son of Herman and Minnie Blunk Boeck, was born April 19, 1906, in East Boyer twp., Crawford co. He was raised on the family farm and attended rural school, East Boyer No. 9.

On Dec. 29, 1927, he married Mary Cecilia Knott. They lived in Manilla where he was a mechanic for several years before starting his own business. After his first wife's death, he married Ramona Grau at Arcadia.

He owned and operated Jack Boeck Construction, Manilla, for nearly 40 years before his health prevented him from being as active during the summer of 1983. He had been in failing health for several months before his death on Friday, March 30, 1984, at St. Mary's Hospital, Rochester, Minn. He was 77 years, 11 months, and 11 days of age. He was a member of the Trinity Lutheran church, Manilla.

He was preceded in death by his first wife; his parents; two brothers: Ralph, in infancy and Benton Boeck and one great grandson, Sammy Kremin.
