Walnut — Orville Bornholdt, was born Oct. 28, 1894 west of Atlantic and lived in Cass and Shelby counties all his life. He was raised by George Bornholdts, since the age of three and attended the Atlantic schools.

He married Margaret Brink on Dec. 31, 1919 in Atlantic. He was a veteran of WWI serving with the Army and was a member of the American Legion in Atlantic. He died Thursday, July 5, 1979 at Cass County Memorial hospital at age 85.
