GLENN M. BREEDLOVE, 78

Glenn Mansfield Breedlove, son of John L. and Cordelia Shupe Breedlove, was born Mar. 28, 1895 in Wicox, Mo. He died at Myrtle hospital in Harlan on Febr. 16, 1974, at age 78 years, 10 months, 18 days. As a small child he moved with his parents to Maryville, Mo., where he grew to adulthood. In 1914 he married Beulah Gale Kidd in Maryville, Mo., and three children were born to this union. Mr Breedlove lived in the communities of Omaha and Lincoln, Nebr.; in Billings, Mont.; and in North Little Rock, Ark. He moved to Harlan in Nov. of 1973. He has been a member of Billings Masonic Lodge No. 113, A.F. & A.M. and Al Bedoo Shrine Temple, both of Billings, Mont. for many years. He enjoyed Masonic activities and he was interested in this organization through out his entire adult life.

He was preceded in death by one son, John Breedlove; by three brothers - Arthur, William, and Ted Breedlove; and by two sisters - Mrs Elizabeth Burnside and Mrs Emma Wilmes. Mr Breedlove is survived by his daughter - Lucille Nagel of Harlan; by his son - Walter Breedlove of Newton, Kan.; by nine grandchildren; seventeen great grandchildren; and one great great grandchild; by one brother - Jack Breedlove of Yuba City, Calif. by his nieces and nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held on Tuesday, Feb. 19, 1974, at the Pauley Home for Funerals in Harlan with Rev Peter M. Kemper of the First Baptist church, officiating. Burial was in the Harlan cemetery with Bernard Moran, Parke Marshall, James Petsche, Lavern Petsche, Leonard Petsche and George Petsche, Jr. serving as pallbearers. Masonic services were held at the funeral home by members of Parian Lodge No. 321, A.F. & A.M. of Harlan.
