Robert E. Brodersen, 58

Robert E. Brodersen, son of Grace and Jake Brodersen, long time Harlan residents, was born April 28, 1925 at Fiscus. He died suddenly on July 28, 1953 of cardiac arrest at Bellevue, Neb.

At age 5, he moved with his parents to Harlan where he attended school, graduating in 1942 from Harlan high.
