



**THE LIFE STORY OF —
MISS ZOE BUCK, 85**

Zoe Buck, daughter of Louis and Caroline Bock Buck, was born on a farm near Harlan on June 4, 1890. She died at the Salem Lutheran Nursing Home in Elk Horn on May 12, 1976, at age 85 years, 11 months and 7 days. Miss Buck attended school in Harlan until the age of 15 when she became ill with spinal meningitis. She then lived with her mother until her mother's death in 1947. Since that time, for the most part, she has made her home at the Salem Lutheran Nursing Home in Elk Horn. Miss Buck had been a member of the First United Methodist Church in Harlan, since 1924.
