

Evelyn J. Campbell, 73

Harlan — Evelyn June Campbell, daughter of Hans N. and Marie Mikkelsen Hansen, was born June 4, 1907, on a farm in Monroe twp., Shelby county. She was baptized at the Lutheran church and also attended the country school there. She then attended Harlan high school, graduating in 1924.

On Feb. 28, 1926, she married Ivan O. Campbell. Five sons were born to this union. In Oct. of 1953, she moved to San Jose, Calif., and resided there for 20 years, returning to Ia. in 1973 to make her home in Atlantic, where she has resided ever since. Mrs Campbell was a member of the Harlan Immanuel Lutheran church.

She died at the Cass County hospital in Atlantic on Thursday, Dec. 18, 1980, at age 73 years, 6 months and 14 days.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by one brother, Clifford Hansen and an infant sister, Ruth.
