EARLING — Gayle Hamilton Carter, daughter of Emma Josephine Rust and Edwin J. Trumbauer was born Dec. 3, 1891 at Newell. She died Sept. 10, 1977 at St. Joseph's hospital in Omaha, at age 85 years, 9 months and 7 days. Gayle was educated at Patterson. After her marriage to Walkup Carter on January 26, 1910 in Des Moines, they farmed in the St. Charles area until 1946 when they retired to St. Charles.
