

# Orville Carter, 77

**Manning** — Orville Carter, son of Harry and Grace Kibby Carter, was born Oct. 13, 1902, near Watertown, So. Dak. In 1904, he moved with his family to a farm south of Manilla and in 1910 moved to the Defiance vicinity. He attended the country school near his home and the Defiance public school.

Orville married Grace E. Goodwin on June 23, 1925, at the Methodist Parsonage in Harlan. They farmed near Defiance and in 1941 moved to a farm south of Manning. They retired to town in 1961. Orville has been in failing health for many years but died suddenly at the Des Moines Methodist hospital early Sunday, Jan. 6, 1980, at age 77 years, 2 months and 23 days.

He was preceded in death by two sons, Gailen Lyle and Ival Dean, by his parents and one brother and one sister. He is survived by his wife, Grace, by two children, Leota (Mrs Beal) Austin of Des Moines and Merlin Carter of Manning, by six grandchildren, four great grandchildren and by one brother, Dallas Carter of Defiance, and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Wednesday, Jan. 9, 1980 at Ohde Funeral Home in Manning with Rev. Donald Jones, of the United Methodist church, Manning officiating. Burial was in the Manning cemetery.
