Lillian Louise Christensen was born to Jesse and Helena Frost Andersen on Sept. 19, 1902 in Audubon co. She was one of 15 children. She was baptized and confirmed at Oak Hill in the Lutheran faith west of Brayton. She attended Audubon co. schools.

On March 31, 1920 she married Chris B. Christensen in Atlantic. They farmed at Wiota and Anita until 1940 when they purchased a farm south of Brayton. In Aug. of 1978 she entered the Salem Nursing Home at Elk Horn where she died Sunday, Dec. 11, 1983.
