Thomine P. Christensen was born Nov. 30, 1906, northeast of Kimballton in Audubon co. She was the daughter of Chris T. Clausen and Jensine Caspersen Clausen. She married Segard Christensen, Feb. 22, 1931 and they lived in Manning and Irwin area for four years before moving to the family home, northwest of Kimballton.

She was baptized and confirmed in the Immanuel Lutheran church in Kimballton where the family were members until Segard died in 1962, then he joined the World Wide Church of God in Omaha, where she has been a faithful member.

During her life on the family farm he has been devoted to her family and church, also she was a member of a local neighborhood club named J.O. club, organized by farm families in the area of the country school and named after the Jackson school district number one.

She died at Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan on Wednesday, July 6, 1983 after two years of poor health.

She is survived by her one daughter, Verleen Benton of Audubon; four sons, Glenn Christensen of Svendborg, Denmark, David Christensen of Harlan, Gerald Christensen of Harlan and Robert Christensen of Atlantic; ten grandchildren and two great-grandchildren; 2 sisters, Amalia Mikkelsen of Los Angeles, Calif. and Martine Hansen of Hespria, Calif.; three brothers, Mads Clausen of the Salem Lutheran Homes in Elk Horn, Nels Clausen of Antia, and Christian of Anita Care Center in Anita. Preceding her in death were her parents; her husband, Segard in 1962; four sisters, Anna Jorgensen, Solvig Clausen, Christine Sorensen and Valborg Sorensen and one brother, Casper.

Funeral services were held at the Graveside Friday, July 8, 1983 in the Immanuel Lutheran cemetery in Kimballton with Jerry Swagerty, minister of the World Wide Church of God.
