Harlan — Roy Harold Christiansen, son of Charles P. and Emma Andersen Christiansen was born Nov. 13, 1898, in Monroe twp. Shelby county. He died in Myrtue Memorial hospital on Friday, Dec. 19, 1980, at age 82 years, 1 month and 6 days. He was baptized at the Altamont Baptist church in Cuppy's Grove as a youth, where he was a lifetime member.

On April 3, 1918, he married Olive Viola Rold in Atlantic. One daughter, Mildred, was born to this union. They farmed in Cuppy's Grove for many years and were privileged to celebrate their golden wedding anniversary in 1968. In 1975, Roy moved to Harlan and then became a resident of the Baptist Memorial Home in April of 1977.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Olive, on Sept. 5, 1974 and by one grandson, David Dean Johnson on Feb. 22, 1950; his parents; two brothers, Herbert and Carlton and two sisters, Hazel (Mrs Edwin) Christensen and Ethel (Mrs Edwin) Larson.
