

David Christoffersen

KIMBALLTON — David Andreas Christoffersen, was born Aug. 30, 1899 in Shelby county, son of Kelmman Anders and Karen Andersen Christoffersen. He was baptized in Immanuel Lutheran church in Kimballton on Sept. 13, 1900. He was confirmed in the Poplar Lutheran church on April 19, 1914. David was educated in the rural Shelby county schools and farmed in Audubon county until retiring to Audubon. David married Esther Andersen in 1928. Following her death in 1947 he married Clara Christensen Moller on Jan. 27, 1949 in Trinity Lutheran church in Omaha, Nebr. Clara died at their home in Audubon on Sept. 11, 1971. On Aug. 1, 1973 David moved to the Salem Retirement Home in Elk Horn. Because of failing health he moved to the Nursing Home where he died Thursday, Feb. 3, 1977, at age 77 years.

David was preceded in death by four sisters and one brother. Survivors include one brother - Dick Christoffersen of Kimballton and nieces and nephews.

Funeral services were held Monday, Feb. 7, 1977 in Immanuel Lutheran church in Kimballton with Pastor David L. Peterson, officiating. Burial was in Immanuel Lutheran cemetery in Kimballton with Chester Johnson, Robert Christoffersen, Arno Christoffersen, Lee Miller, Lloyd Nelson and Keith Hartvigsen serving as casketbearers.
