

Valborg Christoffersen, 103

Kimballton — Valborg Christoffersen, daughter of Nels and Karen Mortensen, was born July 30, 1876 in Schlesvig Holstien, Denmark. She was baptized in Denmark and at age four came to the U.S. She was confirmed in the Lutheran church.

She married Chris Christoffersen on March 10, 1898 in the Bethany Lutheran church near Kimballton. They made their home north and east of Kimballton in Audubon county, where Valborg lived until 1977 when she entered the Exira Care Center. She died Wednesday, April 30, 1980 at the Exira Care Center in Exira at age 103 years.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband and infant son, Willie, five sisters, four brothers and two great grandchildren. Survivors include two sons, Nels and Andrew of Kimballton, one daughter, Karen Petersen of Kimballton, eight grandchildren, 27 great grandchildren, and one sister, Annie Wiges of Elk Horn.

Funeral services were held Saturday, May 3, 1980 at the Bethany Lutheran church near Kimballton, with Pastor Douglas Kahl, officiating. Burial was in Bethany Lutheran cemetery with Arild Christensen, Emory Christoffersen, Dalton Christoffersen, Paul Hemmingsen, Jim Sorensen and Jim Fredriksen serving as casket-bearers.
