GEORGE E. CLAUSSEN, 59

George Edwin Claussen, was born Nov. 28, 1914 in Carbondale, where he attended school and grew to adulthood. He served with the Army during WWII. On June 1, 1946 he married Patricia Donley at Scotland, S.D. The Claussens lived in Defiance, for 16 years before moving to Grand Junction, Colo. He served as commander of V.F.W. at Harlan. He was a member of the Episcopal church. Mr Claussen was a truck driver for the Pease Drilling Co. in Colo. He died on Saturday Aug. 24, 1974 in Veterans hospital following a five day illness at age 59 years.

Survivors include his wife; a daughter - Mrs Kenneth Grogan; four sons, Keiley, Cory, Curt and Scott, all of Grand Junction; a brother, four sisters, and two grandchildren.

Funeral services were held Tuesday Aug. 27, 1974 in the Callahan Edfast Chapel with Rev. Richard W. Foster officiating.
