**MRS CLEM COENEN, 69**

**PANAMA** — Angela Marie Coenen, daughter of Lemuel and Mary Mickels Waltz was born July 21, 1904 on a farm in Washington township in Shelby county. She died at Archbishop Bergan Mercy hospital in Omaha, Nebr., on July 11, 1974, just ten days before her 70th birthday. As a small girl she moved with her parents to Canby, Minn., where she attended school and grew to adulthood. On June 16, 1936 she married Clem Coenen in St. Peter's church in Canby, Minn. After their marriage Mr and Mrs Coenen farmed west of Westphalia until Nov. of 1963 when they moved to their present home in Panama. Mrs Coenen was baptized at St. Mary's church Panama and confirmed in St. Peter's church in Canby, Minn. After their marriage she was a member of St. Boniface Rosary Society, until the fall of 1963 when she became a member of St. Mary's church in Panama. She was preceded in death by her parents and one brother John Waltz.

Mrs Coenen is survived by her husband, Clem, by her daughters Darlene (Mrs Ivo Wilwerding) of Westphalia, Miss Joan Coenen of Omaha, Nebr., Deloris (Mrs Lester Rains) of Phoenix, Ariz., Yvonne (Mrs Thomas Morfeld) of Lincoln, Nebr., by her sons, Duane Coenen of Millard, Nebr., and Norm Coenen of Des Moines and by 18 grandchildren, by four brothers Leo Waltz of Panama, Jacob and Nicholas Waltz of Canby, Minn., Andrew Waltz of Brainard, Minn., by three sisters, Gertrude (Mrs Joseph Hoffmann) of Owatonna, Minn., Mrs Agnes Papineau of Morris, Minn., and Cecelia (Mrs Carl Reisz) of Panama, by her nieces and nephews and other relatives.
