Lisa Ellen Croghan, daughter of James and Kathleen McAllister Croghan was born Jan. 19, 1958 in Harlan. She was baptized at St. Mary's Catholic church in Panama and at the age of 3½ moved with her parents to Des Moines. Three years later she moved with her family to Annandale, Va. where she attended school and grew to adulthood.

She received her First Communion and confirmation at St. Michael's Catholic church in Annandale and graduated from Thomas Jefferson high school in Alexandria, Va.

At the time of her death, she was a student at the University of South Carolina in Columbia, S.C. She was a member of St. Michael's Catholic church in Annandale. She died as the result of a boating accident in Alton, Ill. on April 6, 1982 at the age of 24 years.

She is survived by her parents, James and Kathleen Croghan of Annandale, Va.; two brothers, Greg of Mount Solon, Va. and Joe of Annandale, Va.; one sister, Anne (Mrs Ken) Giese of Alexandria, Va.; aunts, uncles, cousins and other relatives.

Funeral services were held at St. Mary's Catholic church in Panama on Saturday, April 10, 1982 with the Rev. David Fenelon officiating.
