F. D. ('Curt') Curtright of Harlan, well-known for organizing and directing the City of Harlan Band and the high school drum and bugle corps, died Saturday (Feb. 13) at Myrtue Memorial Hospital, Harlan. He was 86.

Curtright also was active in American Legion activities. He came to Harlan after serving in World War I. His wife, Dexter, served in the WACS and his son Don is a veteran of WWII.

A mail carrier for over 20 years, Curtright also was a member of Masons. He was named Harlan 'Citizen of the Years' at the 1966 Harlan Chamber of Commerce awards banquet.

Surviving besides his wife, a resident of Harlan, and his son, a resident of Miami, Fla., is a sister, Frances Krug of Cedar Rapids, Ia.
