

## Eddythe M. Dodd, 78

Eddythe Mildred Dodd, daughter of Henry and Mabel Taylor Hulsebus, was born June 30, 1903, in Underwood. She attended school and grew to adulthood with her family in Underwood.

On Sept. 26, 1920, she married Free Henry in Omaha, Neb. They spent most of their married life in the Harlan and Defiance areas.

On July 3, 1950, she married Charles W. Dodd in Omaha, Neb. After their marriage, they made their home in Omaha until 1965, when they moved to Harlan. After Mr Dodd died on March 15, 1966, she continued to make her home in Harlan until 1971, when she moved to Portland, Oreg. to be near her children.

She died at the Woodland Park hospital in Portland, Oreg. on Sunday, Dec. 27, 1981 at the age of 78 years.
