WALNUT — Martin William Dorscher, was born May 21, 1912 in Hancock, son of Martin and Sophia Nieman Dorscher. He died March 21, 1977 at Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan at age 64 years, ten months. He married Mary June Mutum of Walnut at Atlantic on Sept. 21, 1935. They farmed until 1963, when they moved to Walnut and he opened a machine repair shop. He was a member of the Walnut First United Presbyterian church.
