

## Max Duke, 71

**SPIRIT LAKE** — Funeral services for Max E. Duke, 71 of Spirit Lake, were held Friday, Oct. 29, 1982, at Donovan-Leyson Chapel, in Spirit Lake, with the Rev. Dick Viney officiating. Duke died Wednesday, Oct. 27, 1982.

Pallbearers were Don Henderson, Milford Riedmann, Gene Packard, Derald Thompson, James Carney and Glenn Gjerde. Burial was in the Lakeview Cemetery, in Spirit Lake.

Max Eugene Duke was born to Thomas H. Duke and Mabel Hamblin Duke at Defiance, on July 14, 1911. On Oct. 9, 1930 he married Fern V. Fick at Denison, and to this union three children were born.

Max was engaged in farming at Defiance, until 1948. He moved to Spirit Lake where the couple purchased a cabin camp. He was also a self-employed furniture upholsterer.
