

# May L. Dunlap, 70

Manilla — May Lenora Dunlap, daughter of Duncan and Nica Durnham Benton, was born Dec. 26, 1906 in Botna. She received her schooling in the rural schools near her home and in the Manning schools. She married Elmer C. Peters on Febr. 2, 1925. This union was blessed with one daughter. They farmed southwest of Manning until her husband died in 1957. She then returned to school and received an LPN degree, after which she worked in several hospitals and later for Dr. J. M. Hennessey in Manilla.

On June 19, 1969 she married Robert Dunlap. They lived on a farm near Manning. She died in Clarkson hospital, in Omaha, Nebr., on Monday, Nov. 7, 1977 at age 70 years, 10 months and 11 days.

She was preceded in death by her parents and one sister. Survivors include her husband - Robert; her daughter - Mrs Ray (Beverly) Schrum of Manilla two grandchildren - Cindy Wolf of Chicago and Robert Schrum of Denison.
