

# John Dunlevy, 67

AVOCA — Funeral services for John Dunlevy, longtime publisher of the Avoca Herald-Journal, were held Monday morning (March 29) at St. Mary's Catholic Church here.

Dunlevy, 67, died Friday at his home in Avoca. He had suffered cancer the past several years.

Dunlevy was advertising manager for the Harlan News-Advertiser before moving to the Avoca paper. He was editor of The Journal Herald until selling the newspaper Aug. 1, 1974 to Donald Nielsen of Avoca, the present owner of the paper.

Dunlevy was a World War II veteran, a member of the Avoca American Legion, and served on the Library Board and Park Board in Avoca. He was news director at KNOD Radio in Harlan for a short time prior to his retirement several years ago.

He is survived by his wife, Lettie Dunlevy of Avoca; two sons, Tim of Avoca and John R. II, of Arnolds Park, Ia.; one

daughter, Mary (Mrs. Gail) Gramkow of Avoca; a brother, Jerry, of Indianapcils, Ind.; two sisters — Mrs. Kathleen Zosel of Des Moines and Mrs. Janet

Lewis of Aurora, Ill.; and five grandchildren.
